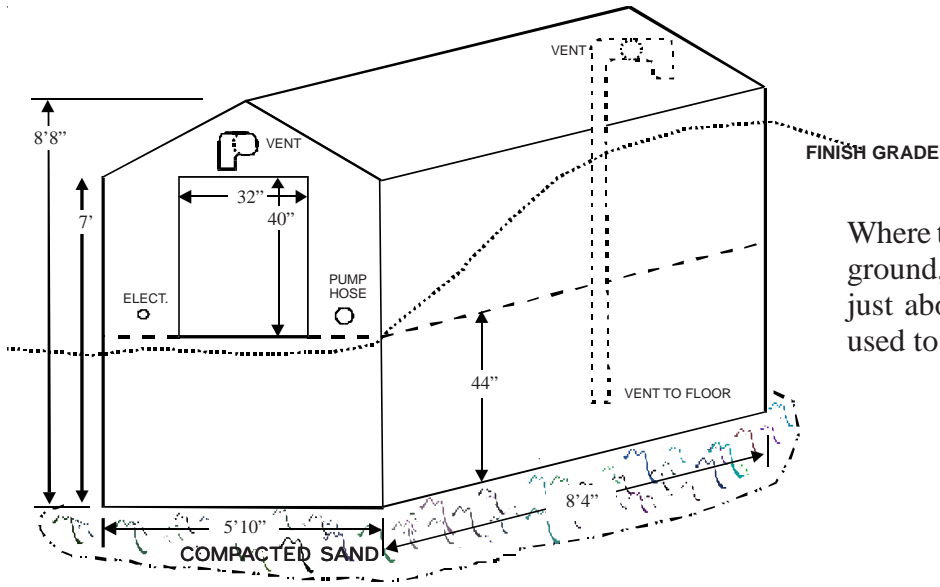
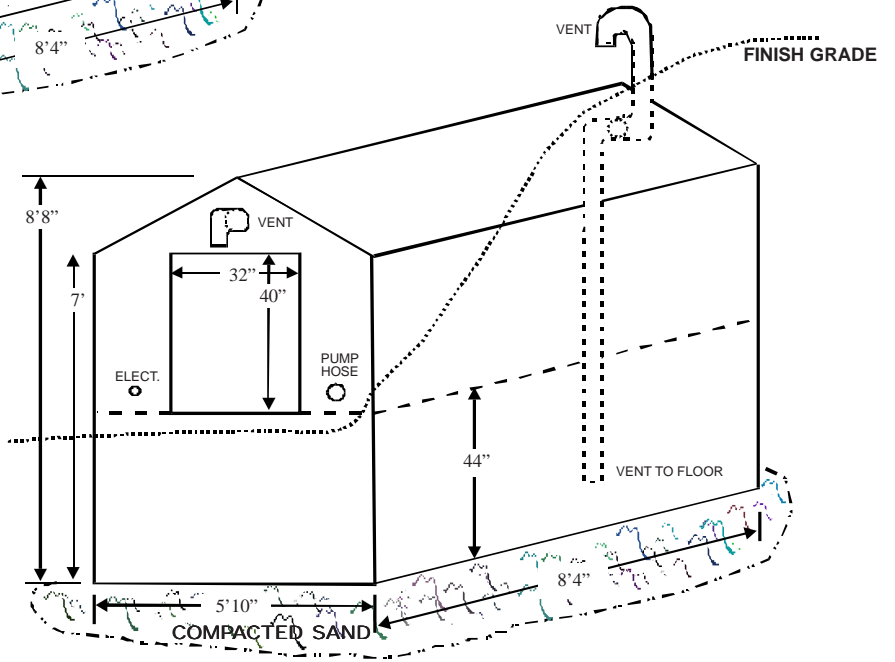


Typical Installations for Storm Shelters



Where there is a high water table and level ground, shelter can be buried with bottom just above water. Dirt from hole can be used to mound around the shelter.

Additional dirt can be hauled in. If there is a small hill, the back half of the shelter can be completely buried for extra protection. The vent is then extended above the ground level.



If a hill is available, for an additional charge we can make a storm shelter with a taller door. The entire shelter can be set in the side of the hill and buried, creating an easily accessible shelter and root cellar.
